## Reporting progress (Aka ma te korero – Learning through Talk)

Next week we will be scheduling meetings with you to discuss your child/ren's progress. We will talk through what you are able to see on our Linc-Ed platform and you will have the opportunity to ask any questions and give us any information you think helpful. Please see the attached slip at the end of this newsletter to book a time with your child's teacher to discuss their progress and next steps.

**NB Please note we have an early finish of 1:30pm on Monday 1 July in order for us to fit all interviews in adequately.**

Some of you have attended meetings to learn about our new application that enables you to track your child's progress. You can get on to this platform by following the steps below. If you have any problems logging in, get in touch. Otherwise you can wait till your mid year meeting with teachers and they will help you.

### Step 1

Visit: <https://ngatittoa.linc-ed.com/wp-login.php?action=lostpassword>

LINC-ED is supported on all modern browsers, for example Google Chrome or Safari.

### Step 2

Click the *Lost your Password* button.

### Step 3

Enter the email address you have given the school to send you communication. Click *Get New Password*.

### Step 4

An email will be sent to you containing a link for you to click on. The link will take you to a page where you will see your new password.

If you choose to, you can delete the automatically generated password and enter your own strong, secure password then click *Reset Password*.

### Step 5

Enjoy reading, viewing and listening to your child's learning. Become part of the conversation by writing a comment or adding a 'Like' to the post.

### To install LINC-ED your mobile phone:

To give you quick access to LINC-ED on your smart phone you can simply add a button on your home screen:

#### iPhone:

1. Open your school's LINC-ED site in Safari: schoolname.linc-ed.com
2. Tap on the share icon on the bottom of the page.
3. From the list that appears select '*Add to Home Screen*'
4. Follow the onscreen instructions

#### Android:

1. Open your school's LINC-ED site in Chrome: schoolname.linc-ed.com
2. Tap on the three dot menu and select '*Add to Home Screen*'

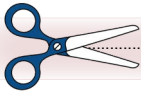

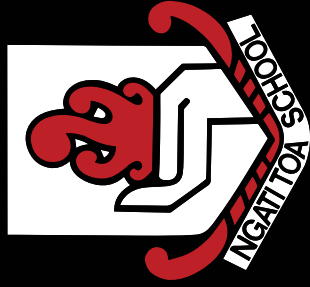
